Letters went home last week to <u>incoming</u> Kindergarteners, 2nd graders, 6th graders, 9th and 12th graders regarding health requirements for their 24-25 school year. Please see below and contact the office if you need more information or have questions. Now is the time to schedule appointments!

Pre-K

- Physical Exam
- Lead Test/Screening
- Immunizations
 - 3 doses DTaP (booster six months after third dose)
 - 3 doses Polio
 - 1 dose MMR (after first birthday)
 - 1 dose Varicella (after first birthday) **OR** documented history of chickenpox

Hib series (or one dose after the age of 15 months)

Pneumococcal vaccine series (or one dose after the age of two years)

3 Hepatitis B doses (third dose received after 6 months of age)

Kindergarten: (LEGAL Birth Certificate Needed)

- Physical Exam
- **Lead Test/Screening** (if not done at preschool)
- Dental Exam
- Vision Exam
- **Immunizations** 4 or more doses DTaP (booster after 4th birthday); 4 or more doses Polio (last dose after 4th birthday); 2 doses MMR (first one must be after first birthday); 2 doses Varicella (first dose after first birthday) **OR** documented history of chickenpox

2nd Grade

Dental Exam

6th Grade

- Physical Exam
- Dental Exam
- **Immunizations** 1 dose Tdap (tetanus/diphtheria/pertussis); 1 dose MCV4 (meningitis vaccine) given on or after 11th birthday; Previously required vaccines

9th Grade

- Physical Exam
- Dental exam
- **Immunizations** Previously required vaccines

12th Grade

• Immunizations 2 doses MCV4 (meningitis) second dose given after 16th birthday; Previous required vaccines

All exams are due upon school entry and are to be done no earlier than one year prior to school entry. All new students must meet these requirements; any new student from out of state must also have a vision exam.
