We are pleased to announce the implementation of educate at PCA.

educate is a student information system tied to TADS that makes key academic information readily available to parents of students enrolled at Princeton Christian Academy.

Beginning January 2025, parents will gain online access to attendance, course documents, assignments, grading, and report cards; enabling them to track their child's academic development going forward as they progress throughout their enrollment.

educate is portable. It works on any device — PC, phone & tablet.

Parents will be able to access vital information at any time from anywhere using an individualized portal to their customizable dashboard, featuring not only their child's academic information, but the school calendar, announcements, and a school directory shared by participating parents.

In preparation for this access, we urge parents to review all of their household information in TADS, to be sure that it is accurate and current, including e-mail and contact information. Outdated information will likely impede this access, for educate draws on TADS information as its foundation.

By God's design, parents are in the rightful place to lovingly shepherd their children and nurture them to experience the joy of godly personal growth and achievement. From an academic standpoint, we are happy to provide **educate** as a tool to assist them along the way.

In Bible memory, we are reviewing Psalm 1:1-3 and Psalm 23, mastering Romans 3:19-26, and introducing Romans 4:2-5.

We are working hard in our readers this week, doing lots of one-on-one reading instruction, as we continue to review the phonics we have done to this point as a group. We are learning more consonant clusters this week while reviewing our other special sounds.

In numbers we are reviewing tens and continuing to work on simple addition.

2nd grade ~ Mrs. Bickett

Bible: We are learning how Elijah was bold in challenging the prophets of Baal. We will talk about being sure to put God first in our lives. Our new passage of Scripture is Isaiah 9:6 "For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace." We will work on this verse until we break for Christmas.

Phonics and Language: This week we are continuing to make nouns plural. We've learned when to add s, es, and to change y to i and add es when there is a consonant before the y. We are also learning plurals that completely change their spelling like woman to women. We will also learn how to make words possessive by adding an apostrophe s.

Spelling: We are studying list 14 words. Spelling test 14 will be given on Friday.

Math: We will learn the 15 subtraction family, adding 5 digit numbers with carrying to the thousands place, counting half dollars and reading scale drawings.

History: We are learning about cowboys, westward expansion and immigrants and their contributions to our country.

English - we will continue to work with addressing envelopes, abbreviating road names, and using quotation marks.
