

Our Valentine's Day party will be on Friday, February 14th from 1:00 to 2:55. Don't forget to be working on a holder for valentines. A class list will come home today.

Our in house speech contest will be on Wednesday, February 12th in the am. Parents are welcome to come watch. Please make sure your child has their speech memorized completely by this Friday. We want to work on perfecting them on Monday and Tuesday next week.

Bible: We are continuing to learn about Esther this week. We will see how she was unselfish and how God used her to save her people. Our verse is Philippians 2:4 "Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others." We will recite this verse on Friday.

Phonics and Language: We will are continuing to identify the simple subject and predicates of sentences. We will also learn how to diagram the simple subject and predicate of a sentence. We are learning about subject and verb agreement in a sentence. Add s or es to a verb when there is a single subject. Do not add s or es to a verb when the subject is plural.

Spelling: We are studying list 18 words. Spelling test 18 will be given on Friday.

Math: This week we are working on measuring in centimeters, Roman numerals 1-30, the 17 subtraction family and how to make an addition problem from a multiplication problem.

Science: We will begin our studies in science by learning about the world around us and our bodies.
