Kindergarten and First Grade Families:

We are so excited to announce our field trip coming up next month!

On Tuesday, May 13th, we will be going to the Niabi Zoo. We will leave school at 8:45, and return by 3:00. Siblings are welcome to join our group!

Hallelujah! Jesus is Risen!!! Praying that the break was a time of refreshment for your family and that now we're ready to press on until the end of the school year!

Our field trip to Echo Bluff State Park is scheduled for May 19th. We will leave school at 8:20 and arrive back to school by 3:00 or a little before. Please let me know if you would like to be a chaperone and driver.

Bible: This week we are learning how Martha's faith grew as she saw Jesus raise her brother from the dead. Our verse is John 11:25, "Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live even though he dies; ..." We will recite this verse on Friday.

Spelling: We are working on list 28 words. Our test will be on Friday.

Phonics and Language: We are continuing to learn about adverbs. We will continue to review types of sentences, adjectives, and correct verb usage.

Math: We are continuing to work on rounding numbers to the nearest ten. We will learn how to round money to the nearest dollar and how to write numbers in expanded form. We will also review how to determine the amount of change someone should be given and the ordinal numbers as they pertain to the days of the week and months of the year.

Science: This week we will finish up animal habitats and then learn about insects and the ways God gave animals the ability to protect themselves.

We are beginning Ephesians 5:10-15 and we are also focusing on the 10 Commandments.

We are testing on spelling list 31 tomorrow and then on to 32. We are testing over chapter 13 in history hopefully by Friday. We are beginning a health unit. We are learning adverbs in language and we continue to enjoy fractions in math.
